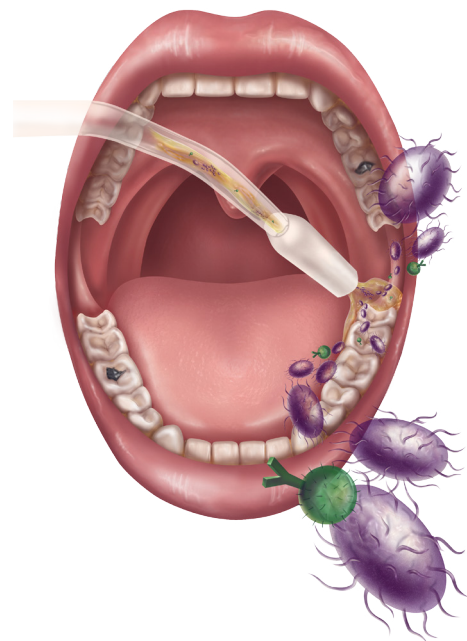
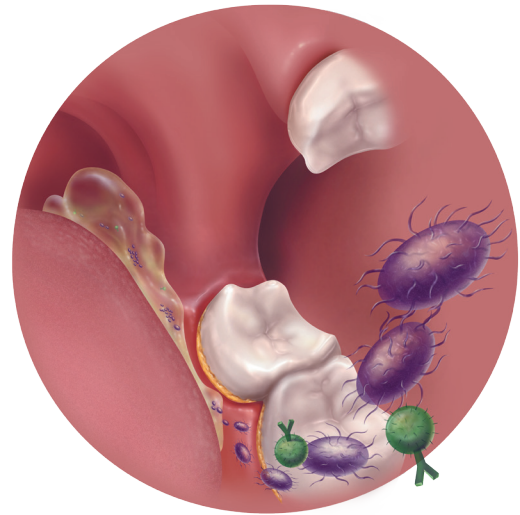


Frequent Oral Care is Important

Three of the Risk Factors for VAP:¹

1. Colonization of dental plaque with respiratory pathogens
2. Bacterial colonization of the oropharyngeal area
3. Aspirations of subglottic secretions*

*Routine suctioning minimizes oral secretions which can migrate to the subglottic area
